DIRECT DEMOCRACY

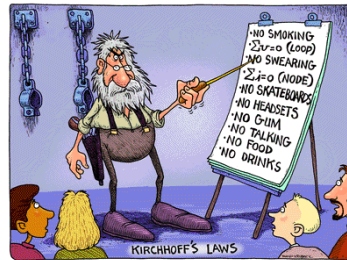
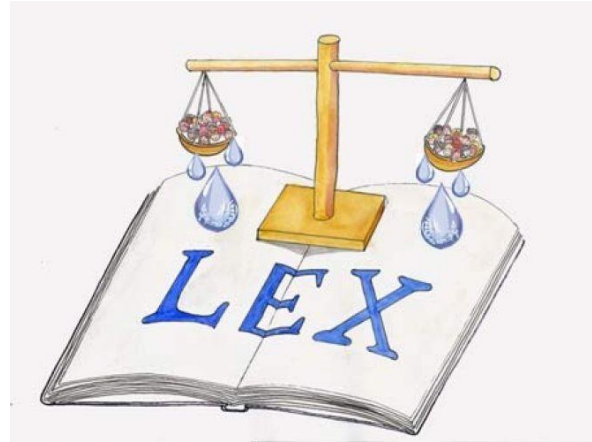

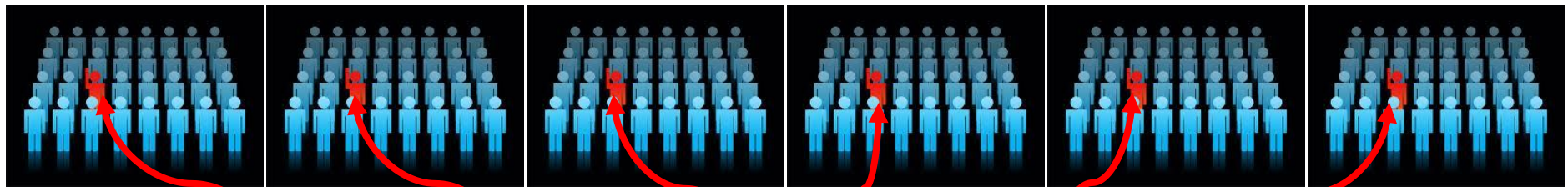


CORPORATIVE DEMOCRACY
